Use


► **Stapled areas:**

Tear off the required length of "ICUTEC Icutape einseitig" and affix onto stapled area.
Done.

Folds:

Tear off the required length of "ICUTEC Icutape einseitig" and affix from the overlap to
the end of the fold on the film.

The substrate must be structurally stable and dry as well as dust and grease-free. It
must also be free of adhesive residues.



Storage

► At room temperature and a maximum relative air humidity of 65%.
